The Chairman, as Acting Treasurer, then gave the financial report. He mentioned that we now had a balance in hand of £105.9.7. left after we had paid 25% of the nett track takings to the council and paying rent and general expenses.

The amount received in fares from passengers was £95.6.9., the odd 3d. producing some lighthearted debate.

He mentioned that while the balance was quite satisfactory, it should be borne in mind that we still had a proper signalling system, a new station, and other expenses to face.
